Privacy Policy

We have created this Privacy Policy to demonstrate our firm commitment to your privacy and security. We want your online visit to be very enjoyable and done with complete confidence. So this Privacy Policy describes how we collect information from our visitors and what we do with the information that we do collect. We want our visitors to be aware of the choices that they have concerning this information, so we recommend that you read this Privacy Policy completely.

Information that We Gather

Our web server generates a temporary log or “cookie” that contains information that helps us analyze the web pages of our website. This allows us to see the traffic patterns on all of our pages and then we can improve those pages for your pleasure and experience. These cookies do not enable third parties to access any of your personal information.

The information that is collected is not associated with specific individuals but is more general such as date and time, web pages that are requested, referring web page, third party ad’s that are selected and computer internet address.

We do not share this information with third parties. However, we may disclose any personal information collected by us if we have received your permission beforehand or in very special circumstances, such as when we believe that such disclosure is required by law or other special cases described below.

Email Inquiries

When Visitors send email inquiries to our site , the return email address is used to answer the email inquiry we receive and we do not use the return email address for any other purpose nor do we share the return email address with any third party.

We may use your email address to include you in our updates or our newsletter, if you request us to do so. If we do use your email address for those purposes, you may cancel at anytime.

Special Cases

It is our policy, not to use or share the personal information about our Visitors in ways unrelated to the ones described above without also providing you an opportunity to prohibit such unrelated uses.

However, we may disclose personal information about our Visitors to satisfy laws, such as the Electronic Communications Privacy Act, regulations, or governmental or legal requests for such information to disclose information that is necessary to operate properly or to protect us and our Members.

Our commitment to Children's Privacy

Protecting children's privacy is especially important to us. It is our policy to comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 and all other applicable laws.
